

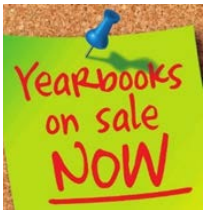


Eagle Update

Chromebook Return

As a reminder, Renton School District high school students, grade 9-11, may keep their Chromebooks over the summer to ensure access and support learning. The only students needing to return a Chromebook will be those who are leaving the school district, which includes our **graduating seniors** who will drop off their Chromebooks.

Additionally, any student **leaving the district** or any family who does not want to continue to have the Chromebook at home over the summer may return the device to the school during the times scheduled below.

Before handing in your Chromebook, please:

- Remove any personalization you added to the Chromebook (i.e. stickers), **DO NOT** remove the asset tag sticker (with the number on it).
- Wipe down and clean the Chromebook, charger, and hot spot (if one has been issued to you).
- Neatly wrap up the charger, brick and cable.
- Place hot spot in box or bag it was issued in.
- We are not collecting laptop bags this year, these are yours to keep.

During the summer, families may receive alerts from our monitoring software if their student has searched for materials which may indicate a self-harm concern. These alerts are meant to provide a family the resources to begin a conversation to address any potential health concerns.
