



Super Important

- One box represents a .50 trimester credit
- In order to earn a High School diploma, you must successfully pass and earn credit for each one of these classes. If it is on this Credit Check form, it is a requirement for your diploma.

If at any time you did not receive credit for a class—grade of **F**, **IN**, **W** or **NC**

Then do NOT mark it off as completed.

If you failed a Core Class (LA, MATH, Social Studies, Science, Health) = you will need to retake it.

If you failed an elective class (Fine Arts, CTE, PE) = you don't need to retake, you can take other elective classes to make up the credit needed for graduation.

MATH

A minimum of three years of Math are required for a High School diploma: Algebra, Geometry & a 3rd year math of your choice.

If earned credits in IEP Math, then you can use your IEP math classes to meet the Math requirements for graduation.

Look for classes with PMA course codes

If you earned credit for Algebra 1 or Geometry at Nelsen Middle School

✓ Check both boxes in the Algebra and Geometry sections

If you earned credit for Algebra Fundamental in trimester 1

✓ Check one box in the Electives section

If you earned credit for Geometry A in trimester 1

✓ Check one box in the Geometry section

If you earned credit for Algebra 2A or Core Algebra in trimester 1

✓ Check one box in the 3rd year math section

If you currently taking Algebra 1A in trimester 2 and Algebra 1B in trimester 3

SCIENCE

A minimum of three years of science (6 trimesters of classes) are required for a High School diploma.

PE and Health

• 1.50 credits (3 trimester classes) of Physical Education is a graduation requirement.

Look for classes with PPE course codes

If you earned credit for PE Foundation or any other PE classes in trimester 1

✓ Check one box in the PE section

• Health – a .50 credit of Health is required for graduation.

Most of you have already completed this in trimester 1

✓ Check the box



Hint: If you were in a different district in ninth and tenth grade then you may not have taken Health yet. If you can not find Health on your transcript, then you are going to need to take it next year. It is a requirement for a diploma.

 Website Design, Game Design, Journalism and Yearbook will count as fine arts for meeting your high school diploma however neither class fulfills the fine art requirement for university admissions.

What is the PPR? PERSONALIZED PATHWAY REQUIREMENT



Personalized pathway is for students who are passionate about a field that does not require a 4-year education, they can take 3 credits that will prepare them for a field to replace the 2 credits of World Language and 2nd credit of Fine Art.

Example 1: A student who wishes to go directly to a 4-year university would need to earn:

-2.0 credits of World Language

-1.0 additional credit of Fine Art

-INE ARTS (2 credits, one of which may be PPR)

WORLD LANGUAGE or PPR (2 credits)

Example 2: A student who plans to become a graphic designer, and will attend a 2-year college to start, could take:

- -1.0 credit of Visual Communications
- -1.0 credit of Website Design
- -1.0 credit of Introduction to Marketing

World Language


Two years of a World Language are required for admission to a 4-year university

For University Admissions:

- ✓ 2 years must be the same language.
- ✓ Competitive universities prefer 3 or more years of the same language.
- ✓ Same language must be taken consecutively, no gap year in between

World Language Exam

- ✓ If you can speak, read and write another language then you can earn up to 4.0 credits.
- ✓ This exam is offered twice each year, Fall and Spring quarter.
- ✓ Exams are available in over 100 different languages!
- ✓ Credits earned = number of years of world language for university


3. Alternates are SUPER important-

- You must enter a minimum of 6 alternate choices.
- The master schedule is a complicated puzzle. You need alternates to guarantee a full schedule.
- When finished, review your courses carefully. You will have little to no opportunity to make changes later. If you are satisfied, then simply exit the program.
- If you are a Zero-Hour Band, Orchestra or Choir Student –

Skyward data entry is set to limit you to 7.50 credits (15 trimester classes). Your Band, Orchestra and Choir teachers will provide to the counselors a list of those students who should be enrolled into Zero hour. We will enter these classes for you. Simply communicate with your music teacher and they will have you added.

ENTER YOUR COURSE SELECTIONS. BE SURE TO CHOOSE 7.50 CREDITS. SOME CLASSES ARE ONE TRIMESTER, SOME ARE TWO, SOME ARE THREE.



- Your future plan determines what courses you choose to fulfill your elective boxes.


