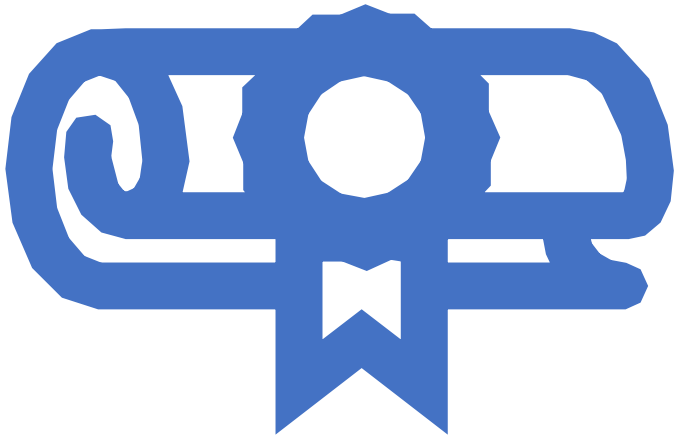

# What is the PPR?

## PERSONALIZED PATHWAY



Personalized pathway is for students who are passionate about a field that does not require a 4-year education, they can take 3 credits that will prepare them for a field to replace the 2 credits of World Language and 2nd credit of Fine Art.

Example 1: A student who wishes to go directly to a 4-year university would need to earn:

- 2.0 credits of World Language
- 1.0 additional credit of Fine Art

Example 2: A student who plans to become a graphic designer, and will attend a 2-year college to start, could take:

- 1.0 credit of Visual Communications
- 1.0 credit of Website Design
- 1.0 credit of Introduction to Marketing

# World Language

Two years of a World Language  
are required for admission to a 4-year university.

For University Admissions the two years must be the same language.

Competitive universities prefer three or four years of the same language.

## World Language Exam

If you can speak, read and write another language then you can earn credit.

This exam is offered once each Fall and again in the Spring.

Your elective choices should prepare you for: “What are you graduating to?”

- Two-year Community Colleges
- Four-year Colleges and Universities
- Career/Technical Trade Schools
- Apprenticeship
- Military
- Employment
- Courses that don’t necessarily apply to any of the above, but look like something you’d like to try (you never know where it might lead!)

Most students take these their Senior Year. \*

A few exceptions:

- ✓ Civics - 1 Tri
- ✓ Contemporary World Problems - 1 Tri

- If you took AP World History as a Sophomore.
  - AP World History C covers similar content as CWP.
  - If you took AP World History C and passed it, then you can put another course in the CWP spot.
- You already took and passed Civics or CWP at a different high school
  - Sometimes other school districts have their students take Civics or CWP in younger grades.
  - If you were in another school district in ninth or tenth grade and your transcript shows that you have already taken and passed one of these then you do not need to take it again.



# Math - it is important

Even if you have already completed your three years of Math

– it is extremely wise to continue to take Math your Senior year.

- **University:** A senior year of math is required for direct admission.
- **Community College:** You want to be able to test into college level math. Tuition is expensive. Learn your math here for free.
- **Technical College/Apprenticeships:** Math skills are required for most trades.
- **Military:** As part of the recruiting process to join the military they will have you take a placement exam called the ASVAB. How you do on the ASVAB is used to determine the job that the military will train you to do. You want them to think you are smart so that you are trained for a good job.

- The two of you should have discussed and agreed upon your math class for next year.

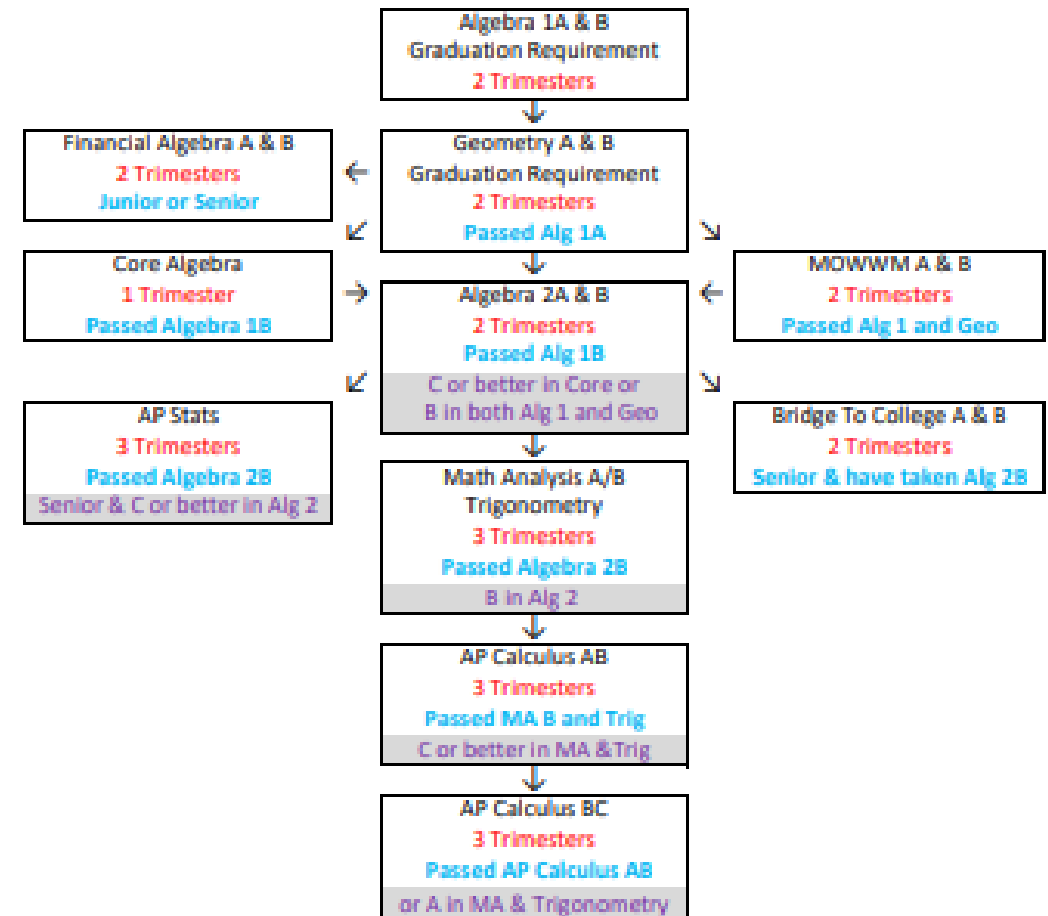
## MATH PLACEMENT 2022-2023

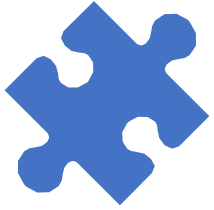



**RUNNING START**

Running Start is a statewide program that provides an opportunity for juniors and seniors to enroll in courses at our local community colleges as part of their high school coursework.

Students may enroll simultaneously in high school and college classes, or solely in college classes. College tuition for up to 15 credits is paid through Running Start. The maximum credit eligible is based on students combined high school and college enrollment. Students are responsible for transportation, books, supplies and applicable fees.

Lindbergh High School students who participate in Running Start are responsible to keep themselves informed about the LHS school calendar and activities. This information is available at the LHS website.

Seniors must also complete their High School and Beyond Plan here at LHS. This information is also available at the LHS website. The high school is the final authority on high school graduation requirements. It is important to work closely with a high school counselor to ensure that you are meeting all your graduation requirements.

Once you begin your college courses, you will be considered a "regular" college student. You will be in classes with adults of all ages. The faculty expects the same level of classroom participation and quality of work from all students. Students are expected to meet class deadlines, be prepared for class, ask questions, and conduct themselves as responsible adults. If students have difficulty or need additional assistance, it is the students' responsibility to seek out the instructor or contact their college counselors.
